- The Participant is a full-time resident of the town of Merrimack.
- The Participant is enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> grade or higher. No participant shall be older than eighteen (18) years of age unless they are a high school senior and will turn 19 during their senior year.
- Said participant is physically fit and permission is granted for his/her participation in the MYA Youth Basketball Program.
- There is secondary insurance and is included in the Program fees at the time of the registration. A deductible on claims for injuries may be applicable. If injured, said participant will be taken to the nearest medical facility for treatment; unless I (or another family member) am present and personally take said participant to another facility.
- No MYA Director, Officer, Coach, or other official shall be held liable for any injuries sustained to any participant in any MYA Youth Basketball activity.
- In the event any participant is issued a uniform or other piece of equipment: I accept full responsibility for maintaining its condition and return of the same item upon completion of the season. I further understand that I shall be liable for its replacement in the event of loss or damage.
- I recognize my responsibility to behave in a sportsmanlike manner, and will encourage said participant and others around me to do the same.
- There will be no consumption, use, or display of any alcoholic beverage at any and all MYA functions whatsoever.
- Fee Administration:
  - The Annual MYA registration fee is included in the basketball registration fee. The fee is paid on a per program basis.
  - A \$30.00 Youth Basketball registration fee at time of sign-up. This is required to offset program operation and insurance costs for participation and volunteers. **NO** refunds will be made after the program starts.
    - Instructional Division:** fee is \$15.00
    - Senior Division** add \$10.00 for the shirt.
    - ? **Active Duty Military** : Families w/ a parent on active military duty, check box.

The MYA Youth Basketball Program is intended to foster teamwork and sportsmanship in a competitive athletic environment. To reach this goal, all coaches, players, and parents are expected to be positive examples of good sportsmanship. Unsportsmanlike conduct will **NOT** be tolerated and is subject to review by the Board. MYA Participants (players, coaches, parents, officials, and spectators) whose behavior creates a problem or violates our sportsmanship standard will be asked to leave and are subject to suspension from the program.

The use of the Merrimack Schools is a privilege extended to the MYA. Like all privileges, it can be lost. Whenever a school rule has been violated and/or damage has been done to any school by any MYA participant, the Board will review the event. If the results of the review indicate that an MYA Basketball participant is at fault; the Board will apply a sanction, which can include suspension from play for one or more games, or a suspension from the MYA Basketball Program in extreme cases. In addition, the parents or guardians of the responsible individual will be billed for all damages.

It should be noted that no personal basketballs are allowed at MYA basketball games, nor in the schools. No food or drinks are allowed in the gyms. Parents are responsible for and must provide **PARENTAL SUPERVISION** for children other than MYA participants at all times in all schools.
