#### **Board Member** (Jaymes)

-CC has been MIA since October

JL recognized all the work she put into the bibs for evaluations but would like to open the position for someone who may want to join that would be more involved since we have not heard from her at all.

Motion passed 7-0-1 to remove CC from the board

JL wanted to let everyone know he will not be running again for Director but would be happy to stay on the board in another position that is less time consuming, like scheduler. Next election is in June so we should start advertising for open positions soon.

We need a board member at all playoff games monitoring play time. If the divisional coordinator can not be at a game or is coaching a game they should ask other members to fill in during those games.

#### Rules/Officials Review(All)

SR mentioned there should be a board member at one of the games that might have some tension due to heightened emotions from last time they played each other

JL will send an email reminding of play time rules and notifying there will be board member presence at the playoff games

**PW Girls** (Jim)- Thanked MH because he has been able to get the peewee girls to play at the halftime of varsity girls games and it has been very successful and enjoyed by all.

*Jr Boys* (Sheri)- Discussed conflict with rescheduled game from the 16th. JL will try to switch it to the following weekend so it does not overlap with the Bow tournament.

Discussed coach of a team not wanting to play in the first round of the playoffs which would result in a bye for the number 1 seed.

Incident at jr boys game with a player who hit head on the court and many were concerned he should not have been put back in the game right away. SR looked up bi-laws which stated that the refs are supposed to evaluate players after head injuries and make the determination of whether or not to allow them to continue playing.

*Jr Girls* (Jen)- All Good - Will be reaching out to SQ for trophies. Thanked DS for encouragement in a game which had a big impact on one of the girls.

# Int Boys (Derek) Not here

JL read parent complaint about refs and coaches during recent game. JL will respond to the family to avoid conflict of interest.

#### Int Girls (Bill) Not here

Complaint from MYA coach, BO, about the Bedford coach telling his players they "play dirty." JB has been at the games and said they play hard, but not dirty.

BO would like to add that the Int Girls are currently the #1 seed going into the playoffs out of 6 teams in their division in the Bedford Basketball League.

JL will send an email at the end of the season to try to encourage 6th graders to stick with the program next year so we can hopefully have enough teams to allow them to play against Merrimack teams in our own program

## SR Boys (Chrissy) Not here

DS said having Friday practice for senior boys isn't great because they all go to watch the high school game instead of practice, which is understandable.

DS agreed it has been a good year in senior boys but reiterated there should be a draft for senior division next year
